

Environmental Policy

Environmental Policy of Cascais Marina is applied to all employees, service providers, visitors, customers, and the community in general.

Its objective is to build sustainable rules of conduct for the use of the marina's facilities and the services we offer, always aiming to improve environmental performance and sustainability.

- Separate the trash and place it in specific containers intended for recyclable waste (paper, plastic, glass, metal).
- Separate organic matter (food waste) and place appropriately in the collectors according to identification.
- Hazardous waste, such as paint packaging, oils, solvents, contaminated cloths, oil filters, batteries, among others, must be delivered to the Technical Area and subsequently collected by a duly licensed company that forwards it to the appropriate destination.
- Yachts washing is only permitted in the area identified for this purpose, located in the Technical Area, where biodegradable and specific products for nautical washing must be used.
- Yachts must be refueled exclusively at the service station, thus preventing negative environmental impacts.
- Discharge of dirty water and sewage must be carried out at the service station, whose pump is connected to the municipal sewage grid.
- Make the most of the natural lighting in the room.
- Consume water consciously.
